Our mission is to help French children learn English whilst having fun, through our interactive and personalised sessions.


Each year we take on 3-4 interns and invite them into the heart of the business. They help support our activity whilst gaining genuine work experience and developing relevant and sought-after skills.



Internship Structure


Each internship is structured to include both a teaching role (working directly with kids), as well as a business role, supporting the company's operations.





50% teaching & childcare

The teaching & childcare sessions are the heart and soul of the company. They are what allows French kids to enjoy learning English. Interns will spend around 15h per week working with kids aged 3+.



50% in a business role

Internships are all about gaining experience and developing skills that will prepare students for a professional career. Interns will spend around 15h per week working on real business tasks & contributing to the growth of the company.




Teaching & Childcare

Interns will spend half of their time embracing their role as an English Brother or Sister.

They'll be trained, given teaching materials and be responsible for:

- Collecting the children from school
- Supervising snack time
- Playing games & leading structured activities in English
- Organising outings & visits (park, zoo, library...)

Interns will receive a salary & benefits:

- 600 euro monthly salary
- Plus Erasmus or Turing grant (400€/month)
- 50% of the Lyon city travel card
- 3 weeks paid holiday (6 month internship)





Application process

Interested candidates must first submit an online application via the website:

They will then be invited to share their availability for a phone interview.

Phone Interview

An initial discussion to learn more about the candidate and their suitability for the programme.

Zoom Interview in English

Scenario based questions to gauge pedagogical experience and motivation for the internship, followed by a short French test.

Zoom Interview in French

To determine French language competency and cultural awareness as well as the logistics of moving abroad.
